Use of health claims data for epidemiological research: examples from studies on drug utilisation and cancer screening

Ulrike Haug's research focuses on the utilisation and safety of drugs in real-world healthcare as well as on the early detection and prevention of cancer, using claims data from four statutory health insurance providers in Germany on approximately 25 million persons. Her group is internationally recognised for advancing the "target trial emulation" (TTE) approach for causal inference from large observational datasets. The talk will include examples concerning drug safety in pregnancy and cancer screening.
